

My Dear Wife August 6th 1867

Write these few lines and send them with David Scrim he is coming to recreate for over Company i want you to get them Spects them old things and take them to the wach Maker and get them fixt and send them with David Scrim to me if you please and fix or make me sum kind of a vest and put in side pockets in it this old vest is very dirty and the back is all done away it was an old back you know when you made it and if you have not send the shirt before David Scrim will come there you can give him the vest the shirt and the Spects send them up in sum mission and you send me sum postage stamps a letter with all the news that is about Pittsburg i dont remember of any thing more that i want but if you want to send me sum thing in small Compas that will be to sum survis or comfort to me you maist i have no News to send at present David Scrim will give you plenty of News when he comes there So no more at present from your

if you cant get my Spects fixt at Pittsburg give them to David Scrim and he can have new frame put on the glasses but you tree at home first i will send you money as soon as i will have it if i dont get payd soon you will better send me a dollar for i shall soon be with out you mai look for twenty and five Dollars for as long as i have money they want me to lend them you can send me a dollar when i want it but what things you send me up smug two or three small plugs of tobacco

want be amiss and one or two packing needles

I send you this tender of the Rebels this is a
ten Dollar Note mind and take care of it
I will send you five and a twenty Dollars

of this rebel money and when I come home
you shall put them in a frame if you have some little
notions that you want to send them with I think
I had anation to send this picture of yours home but
I was afraid that you would not be pleased so
made a kind of a little Oil Case had and a strap to put
around my neck and I can carry it under my shirt
next my skin and near to my heart I like to see
it every day dont forget my sports
