Worcester Oct the 5th 1858
Dear Friend

We avail ourselves of the present
privilege of addressing a few lines to inform you
that we received your kind letter of the 10th
of September last Friday & we was glad to
hear from you & our move. But we was quite
sorry to hear of your afflictions we was very
sorry to hear that your affectionate Mother is
no more numbered among the inhabitants of
Earth but we trust that your loss is her share
of the gain of her we trust she is gone to
that best that remains of the people of
God & we will miss her back to you
if it is not follow her footsteps and we will
finally meet her in Heaven

We are glad to inform you that we are all
well at present & we hope that you will
be in the enjoyment of the same great blessing
when this comes to hand

You desired us to inform you how many children
we have we would answer that part of your
letter by stating that we have four living
and four dead the names of those now living is
as follows viz. The eldest is named Edward
Davis next Mary Francis next John Calvin &
the youngest which is two years old we call
them the children

The names of those that is dead is as follows viz- Elizabeth Ann which was our first born she died when she was between eleven & twelve years of age the next was a boy named George and another named Peter & another named William Henry thus you see that we have had six boys & two daughters but as you desired us to call our next after you we would state that the probability is that we are done for the present at least we hope so. But should such a thing occur which is by no means impossible the probability is that it will turn out to be a "boy". I would inform you that old Mr. Hyatt is dead he died in the beginning of the summer & also Henry Hyatt is dead he died about two weeks ago. You would scarcely know this country now nor the inhabitants for things would be new and people would be strange. Will you please give our best loves to your sister Rachel & family. I would state that I have a niece living in Mooren County from which I have had several letters lately she lives in Lake Township she is married to a man by the name of Samuel Troy.
