our seals and dated this nineteenth day of July 1798

The Condition of the above obligation is such that
whereas the above bound Ralph Burton hath
obtained from the County Court of Charles City an Injunction
to stay all further proceedings on an ~~Indigment~~ ^{Execution} ~~Indigment~~ ^{Indigment}
granted by the abovesaid Jarvis assignee as aforesaid
against the said Ralph Burton

for the sum of fifteen shillings & ten pence wth 5 p^{ts}
interest thereon from the 1st day of July 1798 till payment &
five dollars & twenty five cents & costs
until the matter thereof be heard in Equity in the said County
Court. If therefore the said Ralph Burton

shall well and truly satisfy & pay unto
the said William Jarvis assignee of Robt. Goodrich his
certain attorney his heirs executors, administrators, or
assigns the aforesaid sum of fifteen shillings & ten pence five dollars
