Your pension claim has been allowed to commence on the 8 day  
of October, 1887, from which time you will draw \$ 12 per  
month.

This is the best obtainable rate now, but if your disability increases, or if you have any disability which came upon you while in the service, or resulting from your pensioned disability and not named in your certificate, write me fully and I will get your rate further increased at once.

I here send you some blanks and wish you would favor me by handing them to your pensioner friends who may be—or think they may be—entitled to an increase.
