Dear Friend

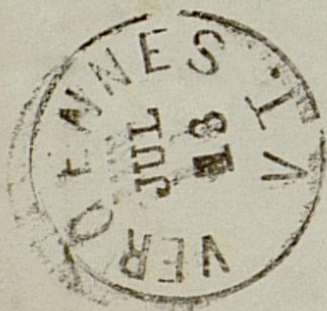
