Dearest Brother

It has been
some time since I received your
very welcome letter, but have
neglected to answer it until now.
We are all well at present, it
is quite cold to night, it snowed
a little this morning but not
enough to do much good, we
have had a heavy of good sleighing
but it rained all day Thanksgiving,
that spilt it, it is sufficient going
with either a sleigh or waggon.

I was in hopes it was going to
snow this morning, but it did
not amount to much. Eli Norton
is dead, he died one week ago

last Tuesday. I expect there will
be an awful row there when they
come to settle the estate, they
cant agree on any one for adminis^{tr}
They wanted Uncle Aaron but he
would not have any thing to do
with it. I dont blame him.
for it wont be a very diserable
job for any one. We have all
been over to see Jennette today
she starts for home tomorrow
morning at six o'clock. she said
she was in hopes that you would
of come home before she went
home. she said she should like
to see you before she went back.
Charlie Green has come home from
Vergennes, he is a going to board
to Mr. Dakis and go to school
this winter. Mr. Blodell is a going
