The faculty met in Pres. Patterson's room at 4 P. M. Messrs White, Shackelford, Kastle, Pryor, Penn, Wernicke and Matthews being present, Prof. White in the chair.

Prof. Wernicke moved that this faculty should recommend to the general faculty that a half year of French should be added to the scientific course in the senior year.

Prof. Matthews moved to amend by adding "and that a thesis be required for graduation in the general scientific as in other scientific courses. Amendment was carried.

The original motion as amended was then carried.

A roll call of scientific students was then made by Prof. White and the work of individual students discussed.
