Building

Prof. Miller reported progress in arranging for dedication of the new Natural Science Building and that he was corresponding with Prof. Shaler of Harvard University with reference to an address upon that occasion.

Mr. Hiatt

Prof. White reported that he had informed Mr. Hiatt of the action of the faculty at its last meeting concerning his candidacy for graduation and that Mr. Hiatt had withdrawn from College.

J. N. Harper.

Prof. White reported a conference with Mr. J. N. Harper and that he believed that the Bachelor's degree of the Mississippi college was not equal to our own.

Prof. Miller moved and Mr. Mathews seconded, that Mr. Harper be recommended to the general faculty as a candidate for the degree of M. Agr. Prof. Wernicke moved an amendment, which was accepted by the original movers, that Profs White and Mathews should arrange Mr. Harper's course. Motion as amended carried.

Voted - Upon motion of Prof. Miller seconded by Prof. Wernicke that R. B. Hamilton be recommended to the general faculty as a candidate for graduation.

Prof. White read list of Scientific course students for a discussion of their work.
