IN 1986, THE KENTUCKY GENERAL ASSEMBLY APPROPRIATED FUNDS FOR RENOVATION OF THE NEW CAPITOL GROUNDS AT THE REQUEST OF GOVERNOR MARTHA LAYNE COLLINS. THE SCOPE OF THE 1986-1987 GROUNDS RENOVATION INCLUDED THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE CAPITOL TERRACE, AND THE INSTALLATION OF NEW LIGHTING STANDARDS, CURBS, AND SIDEWALKS.

A NEW LANDSCAPING WAS DESIGNED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ORIGINAL 1910 MASTER PLAN. THE RENOVATION WAS COMPLETED UNDER THE JOINT SUPERVISION OF THE OFFICE OF HISTORIC PROPERTIES, THE HISTORIC PROPERTIES ADVISORY COMMISSION AND THE DEPARTMENT FOR FACILITIES MANAGEMENT OF THE FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION CABINET.
