

Dr. Joseph Kurre Dies Of Heart Attack Sunday

Dr. Joseph H. Kurre Sr., 50, physician, died at 5 a.m. Sunday at his home, 1520 Deane Avenue, after suffering a heart attack.

He had practiced his profession in Owensboro since 1947, following his graduation from the University of Louisville Medical School. Dr. Kurre attended Latin High School at Lexington, Ky., and graduated from the University of Kentucky, and later from the University of Louisville.

Dr. Kurre was born in Nicholasville, Ky., Jan. 13, 1918.

He was a member of St. Stephen Cathedral, Daviess County Medical Society, Kentucky State Medical Association, American Medical Association, an honorary member of Alpha Kappa Kappa medical fraternity, and a veteran of W. W. II.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Mary L. Kurre; two sons, Joseph H. Kurre Jr., a student at University of Louisville, John T. Kurre, student at University of Kentucky; and two daughters, Martha and Jane Kurre, both at home; a brother, John E. Kurre, of Nicholasville and a sister, Mrs. Mary Ann Brophy of Covington.
