

October 28-1897.

- The scientific faculty met at 4 P.M. in Pres. Pattersons room, Prof. White in the chair, Messrs. Shackelford, Kastle, Garman, Pryor, Pence, Wernicke, Miller and Mathews present.
- Voted; upon motion of Prof. Wernicke, seconded by Prof. Miller, that on account of conflicts in his course, Mr. Hiatts case as a candidate for graduation should be reconsidered.
- After remarks upon Mr. Hiatts case by Profs. Miller, Kastle, Wernicke and Shackelford Voted; upon motion of Prof. Shackelford, seconded by Prof. Kastle that Dean White confer with Mr. Hiatt and advise him that it is not expedient that he should graduate this year.
- Prof. White presented the case of Mr. Newman who desires to be a candidate for graduation.
- Voted; upon motion of Prof. Shackelford, seconded by Dr. Pryor that Profs. White Wernicke Miller and Mathews, confer with Mr. Newman and determine what arrangements can be made to meet the conflicts of studies in his course.
- Mr. J. N. Harper's case was taken under consideration.
- Voted; upon motion of Mr. Mathews seconded by Prof. Miller that Mr. Harper shall arrange his course of study for the Masters degree, with Prof. White.
- Prof. Miller moved that this faculty recommend to the general faculty that some dedicatory exercises be provided for in the new Natural Science building.
- Prof. Wernicke with the assent of Prof. Miller seconded the motion with the amendment that some scientist should be invited to deliver an address upon that occasion. Carried. Adjourned.
