Prof. Pence called attention to the lack of opportunity for students to take extra work in Physics before graduation as they have opportunity to do in Biology and Chemistry.

Prof. Shackelford moved that this matter be referred to a committee, and, with an amendment to have this committee report at an earlier date than the next regular meeting, the motion was carried.
